Applications are now invited from UWA medical students entering 5th Year in 2010 who wish to undertake a four-week cancer clinical attachment during their enrolment.

This attachment would benefit students that have an interest in cancer and would combine their 5th Year two-week cancer clinical attachment with a two-week option in cancer to be undertaken at Lund University in Sweden.

The attachment can occur sometime in the six-week period between **10 May and 18 June** and would include the two week mid semester vacation.

There are two scholarships available of \$3,000 each generously provided by the Virtual Medical Centre to assist with travel and accommodation costs.

A brief essay on ONE of the three topics listed below (maximum of two A4 pages) must accompany the application:

- Angiogenesis' and Cancer Treatment
- PARP Inhibitors in Breast or Ovarian Cancer
- Insulin-like Growth Factor Receptor in Cancer Therapy
